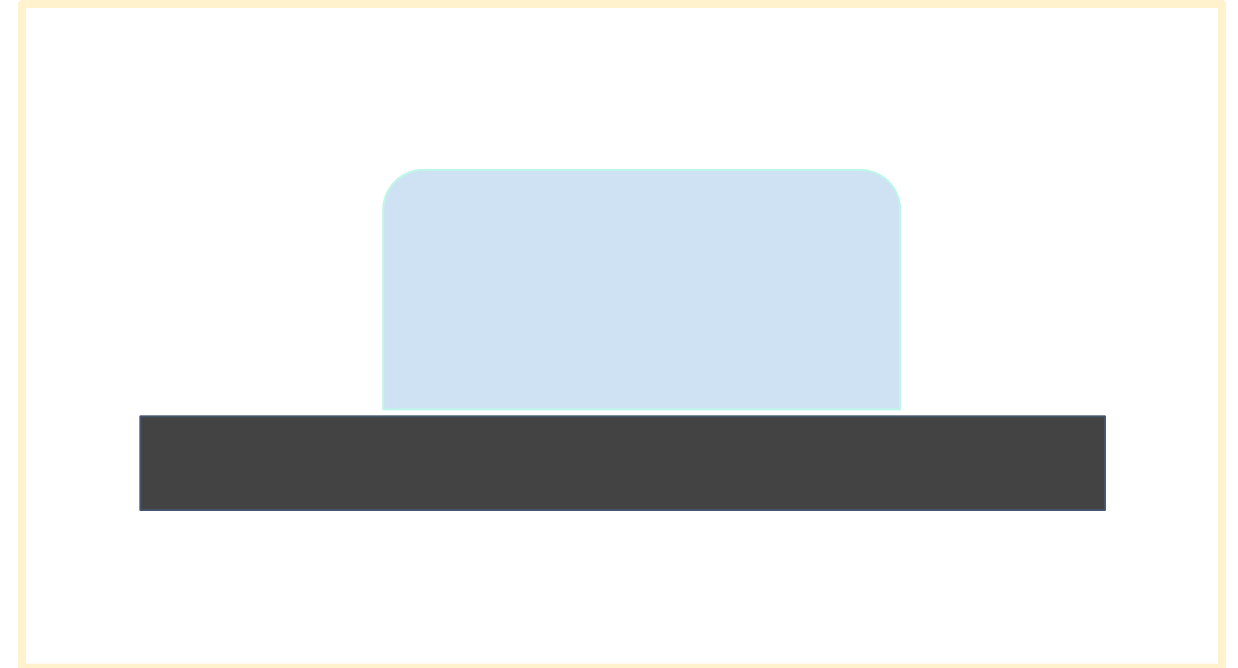


Warm-up Your Brain And Make A Prediction
